## SATURDAY SWIMMING TUITION

These courses are for absolute beginners to swimmers who want to improve their stroke and confidence.

Your child will be taught by a fully ASA qualified swimming teacher in a superb shallow pool with a maximum of eight children to a lesson. An excellent environment to learn in!

#### ADULT AND CHILD CLASSES (no age restrictions)

These classes build confidence in both parent and child. We'll teach you the necessary skills with plenty of hands-on interaction, playing and fun. Toddlers will also begin to learn independence and basic swimming skills.

#### NON-SWIMMER (needs support)

Perfect for parents who are looking to teach their child how to swim, but perhaps need a little bit of help and direction. Again, lots of fun and appreciation of the water.

#### BEGINNER (feet off floor for a short distance)

The children swim independently of their parent with teacher supports they learn the skills to propel themselves.

#### IMPROVER (swim a width confidently)

Learn the skills and strokes of front-crawl, breaststroke and back-crawl, whilst having fun learning to swim.

#### CRASH COURSES

These consist of either four or five half-hour lessons, Monday to Friday, where the children will learn the skills of swimming and confidence building with each day.

All applications and payment must be received 4 weeks prior to course commencing.

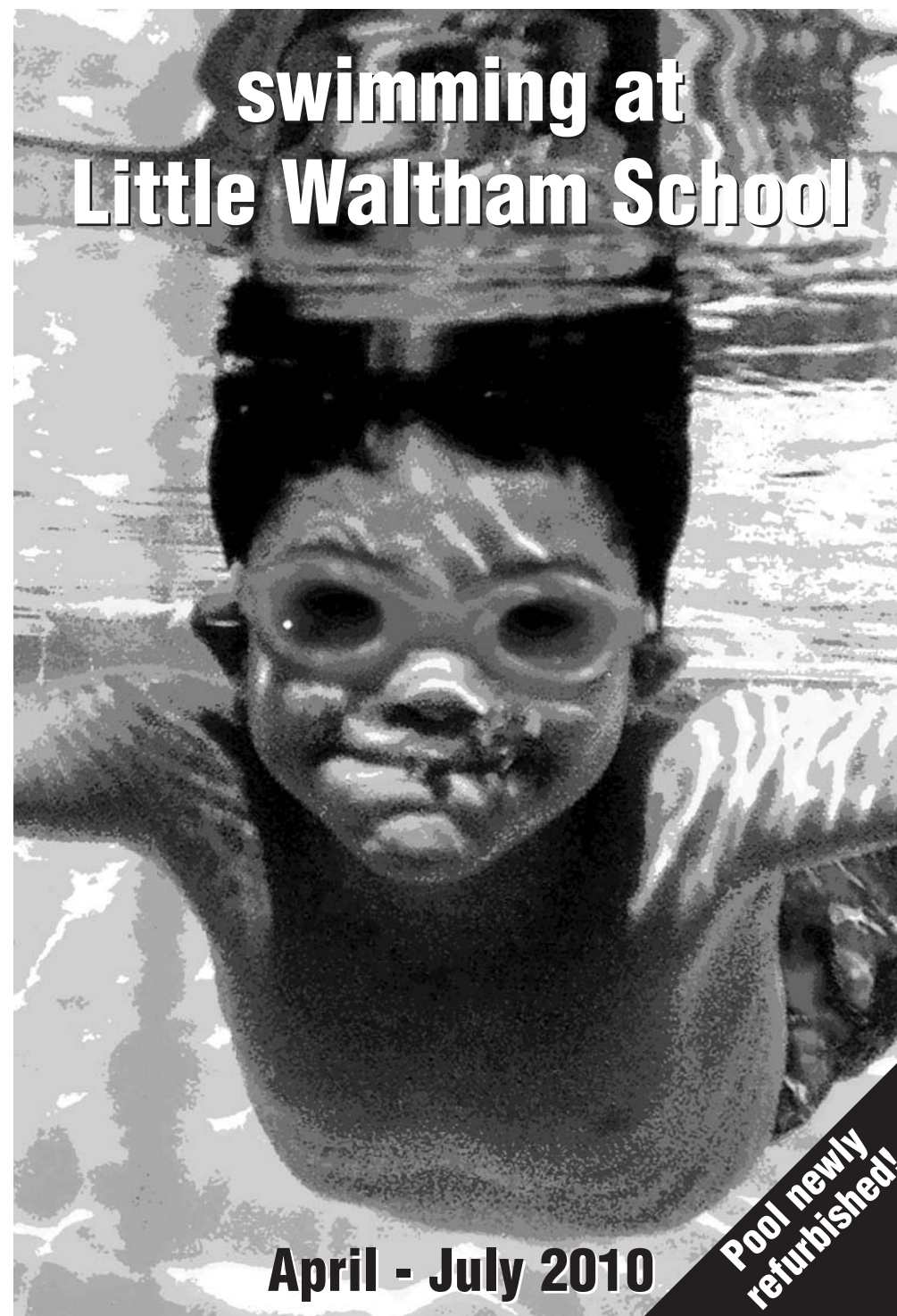
Confirmation of place and payment will be sent to you as soon as possible.

- 3) No refunds will be made for non-attendance at lessons
- 4) Friends of Little Waltham will reschedule any lessons cancelled due to instructor illness or unforeseen circumstances
- 5) Any child who has had sickness or diarrhoea should be clear of symptoms for 48 hours before attending a lesson.
- 6) All children must wear a swimming hat. These can be purchased from the swimming instructor.
